



## Notice of Completion - Huronario/Main Street Study

The Cities of Mississauga and Brampton initiated the Huronario / Main Street Study in 2008 to develop a Corridor Master Plan that integrated rapid transit, land use and urban design in the Corridor extending from Port Credit to Downtown Brampton. This study supports the vision identified by Metrolinx and the municipalities for moving people and goods, and accommodating future growth. The Metrolinx Regional Transportation Plan identified rapid transit for the Huronario / Main Street Corridor as one of 15 "priority projects" for the Greater Toronto and Hamilton Area.



### Environmental Assessment

The Huronario/Main Street Study was carried out in accordance with the *Environmental Assessment Act* and has completed Phases 1 and 2 of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) process (October 2000, as amended in 2007) for Master Plans.

### Public Consultation

Following a Notice of Commencement, the first Public Information Centre (PIC) held in June 2008 provided background information on the study. The second PIC was held in June 2009 to present the study's findings, potential rapid transit alignment options and station locations as well as the vision for each community along the Corridor. The third PIC was held in March 2010 to present the preferred transit solutions and supporting land use and urban design policy recommendations.

### Final Master Plan

This document addresses the planning process for this project including research, analysis, public and stakeholder consultation and recommendations. By assessing the need, justification and review of alternative solutions, the Master Plan recommends light rail transit technology for the corridor and identifies the general transit corridor alignment, station locations and preferred maintenance facility location. The document includes the requirements of the Master Plan process and functional design for the Corridor.
